PURPOSE:

To define the Central DuPage Hospital Emergency Medical Services (CDHEMSS) policy regarding EMT-B program oversight and to establish program standards.

POLICY:

- 1. All instructors of EMT programs under the oversight of CDHEMSS must meet the following criteria, in additional to the requirements of the programs employer:
 - a. Have and maintain an Illinois Lead Instructor License
 - b. Be in good standing in CDHEMSS
 - c. Have at least 5 year experience in EMS
- 2. Instructors class pass rates will be monitored in accordance with the Illinois EMS Act sections 515.500 and 515.530. Should an instructor(s) have a class with a failure rate of:
 - a. 25-49%, said instructor(s) will meet with the CDHEMSS EMS Medical Director and or the EMS Coordinator to address the pass rates. IDPH will also be made aware of the rate and corrective action plan PRIOR to the start of the next applicable class.
 - b. 50% or greater. The instructor(s) will not be permitted to instruct another class under the CDHEMSS Medical Director pending a reevaluation by the employer liaison, EMS MD and EMS Coordinator. The stay on education shall have no bearing on other aspects of the Instructors profession outside the instruction department.

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
